

Proposed Bylaws Change

Article V, Section 2, Present Bylaws Language:

“An officer shall at the same time of his or her election be an elected Precinct Committeeman and shall be a voting member.”

Article V, Section 2, Proposed Bylaws Change as presented by Larry Schug:

“The purpose of this proposed amendment to the CCRC Bylaws is to give members the opportunity to select their leadership from the widest range of candidates seeking these offices. The laws must be flexible to meet the circumstances. A law is like a reed in the wind. If the reed does not bend in the wind, it will break. Our attempt here is to apply circumstances to the bylaw and make it flexible to the majority rule of the people it attempts to govern.

“Article V, Section 2 – Qualifications of Persons for Office

“Add the following statement:

“A member whose Precinct Committeeman application is pending before the Coconino County Board of Supervisors may be nominated and elected to the office they seek but cannot assume that office until the application is approved and certified. This person may, however, participate in all meetings in an advisory, non-voting capacity.

“Precinct Committeeman, whether they be appointed or elected, may be elected to the office they seek by approved and certified Coconino County Republican Precinct Committeemen.”
